Dear Parents

I'm sure you will have seen that our new 'hut' has arrived in the playground. This will be one of the rooms that will be used by Place2Be. P2B already feels well established within the school. The children are making good use of 'Place to talk'. They are able to self-refer for this support which then allows them to have an allocated time spot to speak with Anders about any worries that they have. They can go alone, or invite some friends to go with them. These discussions are confidential, but if there is anything that we feel parents would need to know, we would communicate with them. Anders is also working with some classes to help with friendship groups. As the service embeds itself at St Anselm's we will also start to offer more in depth support through the use of therapists. This part of the service is done via referrals and will be done in full consultation with the family, who will need to give consent.

Safeguarding continues to be at the top of OFSTED's agenda and is a high priority for all schools. Every school has a Designated Safeguarding Leader (DSL) who is trained regularly in how to ensure that we are following all the correct procedures. I am the DSL in our school, and if you have any concerns about safeguarding, do come and talk to me.

Congratulations to Blue House who are the first winners of our new house point system. The children in Blue House managed to earn more house points than the other teams, by being awarded merits for hard work, good behaviour, good effort or demonstrating good manners and respect for others.
